Our faith calls us to love God and to love our neighbour, especially those who are experiencing poverty and homelessness, and those who are refugee or migrant people. Following in the footsteps of Christ, we invite you to join us in solidarity with our Every Step campaign this year.



The Every Step Camino Challenge with Fr Chris Gorton

One way to get involved is to follow the journey of one of Salford Diocese's own parish priests as he takes on the Every Step challenge.

Fr Chris has chosen to raise funds for Caritas by doing a sponsored run along the Camino de Santiago - a special Christian pilgrimage route - during the months of September and October.

He will start on Monday 16th September and complete the challenge on Wednesday 23rd October. That's 28 school days, depending when October half term is.

Will you join in with Fr Chris in and take on our challenge to help local people being supported by Caritas Diocese of Salford across Greater Manchester and Lancashire?
