## Who we are

We are a small project in Bury town centre, and part of the social welfare charity Caritas Diocese of Salford.

We help rough sleepers, homeless and vulnerable adults, including those with drug and alcohol dependencies. We provide much needed support in finding temporary and permanent accommodation, help our clients to access and appeal benefits, and offer help with other services. We also provide a friendly drop-in centre where beneficiaries can have a shower, wash their clothes and socialise with other people.

## What happens at Red Door?

- There is a friendly community room to socialise in, share a cup of tea, and warm bowl of soup
- Clients can get individual benefits or debt advice, general support and information
- Clients can get help with temporary and permanent housing needs
- There are laundry and shower facilities
- Emergency Dry Food provisions are available
- There is a clothes room for clients who need clothing
- Clients can be signposted to other services
- There is a Women's Group with discussions and activities in a safe space
- We have computers and online access
- There is an Arts Group
